The governments of Germany and Mongolia co-founded the German-Mongolian Institute for Resources and Technology (GMIT) in 2013. GMIT offers the opportunity to study in programs which follow international academic standards and best practices. As a public university, GMIT is a pioneering model of higher education reform in Mongolia.

The MBA in ‘International Management of Resources and Environment’ (IMRE) was designed by GMIT’s Partner University, TU Freiberg, as an Executive MBA for engineers and scientists. This MBA addresses professionals, who strive for an international business degree while working at a company or while taking care of their family. Classes with on-site attendance are held every Thursday and Friday evening, as well as on Saturdays at GMIT - over a period of 4 semesters (2 years) - in English. The study program consists of 120 credit points according to European standards, and it is possible to complete modules separately as certified training sessions.

Why should you get an MBA?

- Prestige: getting the world's most sought-after business management degree
- Leadership: achieving top-positions in all kinds of organizations
- Entrepreneurship: starting your own business successfully - from scratch to launch
- Salary: attaining higher earnings with an MBA - in Western countries like Germany, the salary-difference between B.Sc. / B.Ec. and an MBA is USD 10,000 - USD 15,000 p.a.

- Green MBA: going "green" is key to improving growth and profitability in businesses - according to a survey among 1,400 decision-makers across 14 countries (published by HSBC in 2018), the main challenge of companies worldwide is to adapt to environmentally sustainable services and products
- Study abroad: joining your classmates in Germany at our Partner University, TU Freiberg - one on one
- Employability: using GMIT's strong links with domestic and international companies in both business (mining, environmental, manufacturing) and science spheres
- English: improving and speaking the language of business and science
- Future-oriented: being ready for upcoming industries like Aquaculture

The MBA in 'International Management of Resources and Environment' prepares you to be "bilingual" in business and science. Therefore, you will be able to integrate ideas and practices from both areas to tackle the challenges of the 21st century.

The degree is a 50/50 split of business and science subjects with a strong focus on the environment. It is characterized by a multidisciplinary approach encompassing ecology, geoscience, mining engineering, law, economics, finance, entrepreneurship, and management. Throughout this degree program, you can expect to be taught using a wide range of approaches such as laboratory work, discussions of real-life scenarios, self-driven projects, interactions with leading industry corporations, and lectures by German professors.

Career opportunities

Graduates will be suited for career opportunities in the renewable energy sector, in the environmental protection sector, and in the resource sector, including mining, minerals processing, and recycling. Furthermore, this “green” MBA opens doors to work as a consultant for investment companies, equipment manufacturers, and logistics firms.

Tuition fees & 25% tuition fee waiver

An international first-class MBA does not come for free. However, our pay tuition fees are competitive: MNT 133,000 per credit point.

If you take all five modules in one semester, GMIT will grant you a 25% discount on your tuition fee. Additional scholarships are available. Furthermore, GMIT offers benefits for companies whose employees are enrolled in the program.

Bachelor's degree in Engineering or in Science

Advanced English proficiency, Level C1, equivalent to IELTS 6.5
